MINUTES FOR CCBC BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING 6:00 pm on FEBRUARY 8, 2021 (via Zoom)

1. 6:04 pm Bono calls meeting to order

2. Minutes of Past Meetings

a. Approved with input from Carolyn about the board approving payment for baffles.

3. Treasurer's Report (Curley)

a. Review Income/Expenses for YTD January 2021.

- b. Curley received 22 household/34 member renewals and 5/6 new households/members in January.
- c. Checkbook balance as of Jan 31, 2021 is \$26,399.

4. Membership (Bono/Curley/Sagan)

- a. 21 households from 2020 are not yet renewed for 2021 (List A); 24 more from 2019 also did not renew (List B).
- b. Sagan reports on results of board contacting the lists: List A 10 have renewed after the phone calls, 6 may renew once in-person meetings resume, 2 won't renew (1 moved), 10 were left messages, 5 without phone numbers received handwritten reminders. List B 4 have renewed.
- c. We have authorized a "Student" membership category: how to implement.

5. Merchandise (Bono/Goodchild):

- a. Blair will finish new checklist soon (Feb or March). How do we determine how many copies to print? Should we contact likely outlets and ask for pre-orders or estimates? Blair expects to finish soon a total overhaul: species, cape cod frequencies. 290 were sold in 2 years. People aren't going into stores as much. No decision on quantity. (Carryover)
- b. Store at Cape Cod Embroidery will open March 8 for 2 weeks. Most recently we earned \$17.67.

6. Young Birder Scholarship (Faherty/Curley):

- Audubon is running camp this year. Emily Swift is going this year; Phoebe Gibson still needs us to
 confirm with her. Chime Pelzom was planned for Costa Rica, but the camp's status is unknown;
 Maria/Mark to check. Board approved she could alternatively pick a camp in the US and we would fund at
 the same level.
- No new awards will be given this year.

7. Teach the Teachers initiative (Curley):

8. Conservation and Education (Goodchild):

- a. Peter is working with Terry Gavin to add a website page highlighting the approved projects (carryover)
- b. Approved Proposal Guidelines need to be updated and then posted on the CCBC website (carryover)
- c. We funded 3 projects in 2019 1 completed and 2 on hold. John to contact them.
- d. 7 funded in 2020, 2 have sent reports. John to contact them.

9. Walks: (Foti)

- a. MJ will put something in next Newsletter about birding opportunities, even though we're not doing formal walks yet.
- b. Put this on March agenda to discuss when/how to do walks.

10. Kingfisher mailings (Warneke and Kennedy):

a. Spring Issue in progress. Lots of photos. 3 articles. Trying to get a conservation project report.

12. Publicity/Public Awareness Status Report (Clapp, Curley, Fang, Foti):

- a. When do we need to print rack cards? (carryover)
- b. Should we print CCBC "business cards" for Club Officers/Directors to carry and hand out?
- c. Maria printed out business cards with the CCBC info. Peter B will send an email to board to solicit ideas on publicity.

13. Status of "Student Chapter" (Curley)

- Student Chapter going well lots of enthusiasm and learning.
- Maria bought some seed herself. She will buy the next bag using CCBC funds (previously approved).

14. New Business

- Planning for May Elections
 - Bono cannot serve for a 4th consecutive 1-yr term as President
 - Clapp is willing to continue as VP but not take on the Presidency; he can serve as VP for one more vear
 - Warneke will not stand for election as Secretary, but she will continue to be active and serve as coeditor of The Kingfisher
 - Bono is willing to continue to serve on the Board, standing for Secretary
 - Three Directorships are up for election:
 - o Faherty (Programs) finishing yet another 3-year term
 - o Floyd (Refreshments) finishing 3-year term after filling position for 1 year.
 - Sagan (Membership) running for election for two more years after being appointed in the first year of a 3-year term.
 - Peggy has recruited her husband to serve on Refreshments.
